

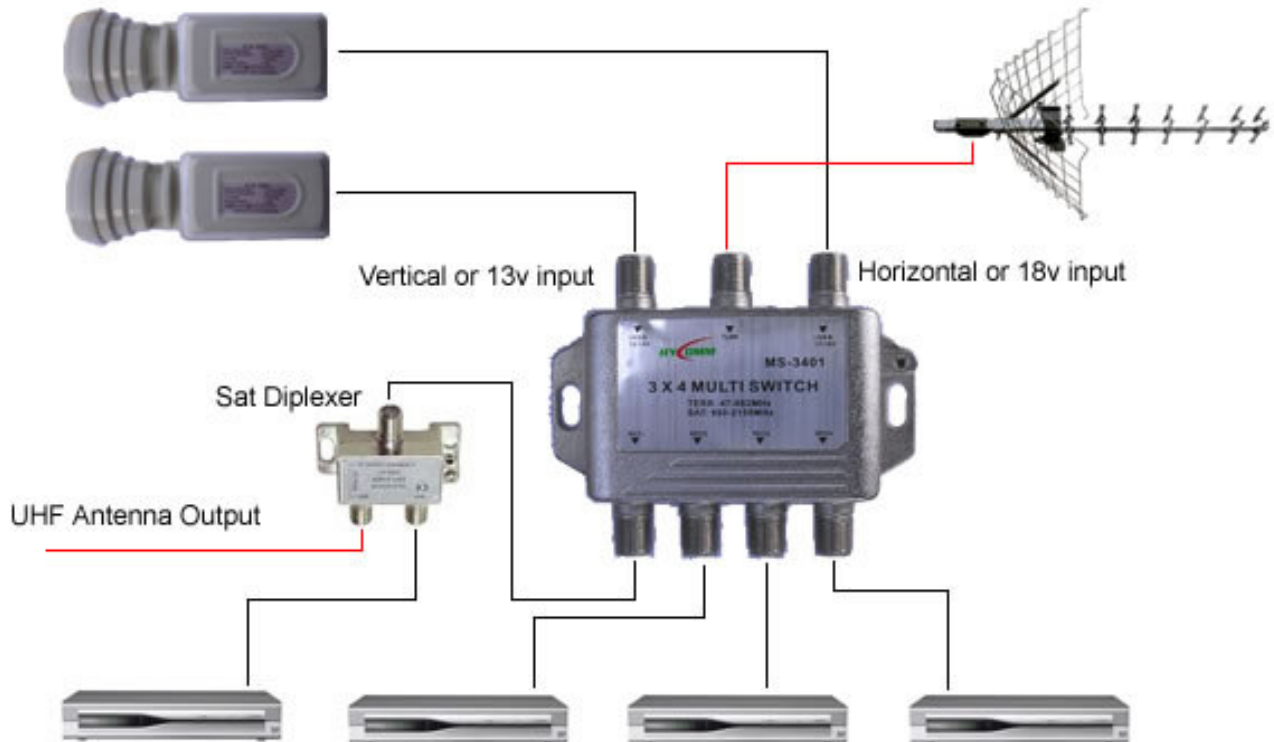


How to have up to 4 receivers use as many as 2 dishes

Many times you want to have more than one satellite receiver in your home, and you do not want to have to add another dish or two for each receiver. By using a [multi switch](#) you can have up to four receivers using up to 2 dishes (or 2 LNBs on a single dish) with no interference.

A basic block diagram for the use of the [multi switch](#) is given below. **The dish for Freeview is always connected to the horizontal or 18v input as the signal from Freeview is horizontal polarity.** LNBs for other satellites can be connected to the vertical input such as Optus C1 or Optus D2. The receiver will automatically be connected to the correct satellite when it selects either horizontal or vertical.



Note that a UHF antenna can be feed through this system also. To use this UHF signal requires a UHF/Satellite diplexer on the outlet to separate the UHF/Satellite signals.
