



## Using “Conditional Access Modules” or CAMs

Conditional Access Modules or CAMs are designed as card readers to allow conditional access to certain broadcasts. Most often the condition of the access is that you make a payment.

However in other cases, such as in Australia, some broadcasts use encryption so that only people in certain areas use the signal. No payment is required.

CAMs are much like a PCMCIA card as used in laptops. In fact the connection is the same.

### **Installing a CAM:**

Make sure the receiver is on standby before inserting or removing the CAM with the card in it. Damage can result if this is not done and will not be covered by any warranty.

Card initialization can sometimes takes 30-60 seconds when channels are selected for the first time.
